Year 8 Parents' and Options Evening 31 January 2019

We warmly invite you to the Year 8 Parents' Evening on Thursday 31 January 2019 between 4.15pm and 7.30pm. This evening is an opportunity to discuss the progress of your son/daughter with their subject teachers and to discuss their potential option choices for Key Stage 4.

Meetings with your child's subject teachers will take place in the Maths/English block. Teachers of subject areas not taught in year 8 will be on hand to speak with you regarding option choices in the Judith Morgan Building where careers information will also be available. Option Choices presentations will also run at set times during the evening.

Appointments to meet with subject teachers can be made through Parents Evening System which is the school's online booking system. The system will be open for the booking of appointments from midday on Tuesday 22 January until midday on Wednesday 30 January.
