Re: Additional Support for Examination Success

Following the latest mock examinations and teacher forecasts, we are writing to you with regards to how we would like to support your son/daughter in the run up to the real examinations they are taking in May.

Currently your son/daughter is being forecast a U (Ungraded) in either History, Geography or Religious Studies. In the teacher's professional opinion, this will be the end outcome for these students in these subjects and so we are recommending that we withdraw their entry for the highlighted subject. This will reduce stress and anxiety leading into the examination season and allows for additional study in other subject areas and for revision.

We would like to support your son/daughter's success further by providing some additional sessions in Maths and/or English to maximise progress in these subjects.
