## Autumn term Christianity

Students will explore the key features of Christian belief. They will be able to express the key features of Christian belief and to define and discuss the meanings of the term Christian. Students will be encouraged to create a description of the Christian idea of God then using the information, complete questions on Jesus. Students will draw and explain the meanings of Christian symbols. Students will look at symbolism, hierarchy, worship and key beliefs in various denominations. to the life of a believer in Britain today

## Spring Term Hinduism

Students will learn about the core beliefs (morals and prohibitions) and practices (worship, festivals) of Hindus including their historical roots and their engagement with society today. Students will have done some work on Hinduism at KS2 usually with particular focus on Diwali.

## Summer Term Sikhism

Students will learn about the core beliefs (morals and prohibitions) and practices (worship, the 5 Ks, festivals) of Sikhs including their historical root with the Gurus and their engagement with the Guru Granth Sahib today.
