SUPERVISED REMOTE LEARNING BOOKING SYSTEM

Thank you for your continued support as we once again transition to remote learning. As you are aware, we continue to provide onsite education "Supervised Remote Learning" for those children who meet the following criteria:

- All family members classified as critical workers [Government definition](#);
- Vulnerable children and young people including those with an Education Health and Care plan.

For more detailed explanation of those families who meet the criteria please see the link above.

We therefore need to launch the booking system for the supervised remote learning at SDCC.

Each Monday, you will receive an email with a link to the booking form. If you require a place in the Supervised Remote Learning provision for the following week, please complete the form by the Wednesday at 11.00 am to ensure we can make the necessary arrangements to support your child in school. Dates will be made clear on each form but essentially provision **must** be booked by the Wednesday of the previous week.

The link for the week commencing Monday 11 January is [here](#). If you do not have access to this form, please phone the school to book.

Whilst in school we will be able to provide lunch provision through the canteen. Please let us know if you would like to take advantage of that. Students' cashless accounts will be used to pay for these as before. Please ensure that balances remain topped up via parent pay.

The students are located in the Maths and English block and the Library and have access to a computer to enable them to access the live online learning. Please, where possible, ensure that your son/daughter has a set of cabled headphones so that they can listen to the lesson. Furthermore, students should be in full school uniform. The areas will be well ventilated so students can wear an additional jumper should they need to.
