Supervised Remote Learning

This is your weekly email reminding you to please complete the booking form should your son/daughter require a place at the South Dartmoor Community College and Atrium Supervised Remote Learning Provision.

Those families who meet the following criteria are invited to book a place for their son / daughter should they require it:

- All family members classified as critical workers [Government definition](#).
- Vulnerable children and young people including those with an Education Health and Care plan.

If you require a place in the Supervised Remote Learning provision, after half term, please complete the form by **Friday 12th February 2021 at 12.00 noon** to ensure we can make the necessary arrangements to support your child in school. It is essential that this form is completed for all children **every week** please. Failure to complete the request form may result in a place not being available for your child.

As stated in my previous email, we will now only be able to provide a lunch provision for students which are in receipt of free school meals. If your child does not receive a free school meal, please ensure you send them to school with enough food/water to last the whole day.

The students are located in the Maths and English block and the Library and have access to a computer to enable them to access the live online learning. Please, where possible, ensure that your son/daughter has a set of cabled headphones so that they can listen to the lesson. Furthermore, students should be in full school uniform. The areas will be well ventilated so please make sure that they have an additional jumper should they need it.
