After a hugely successful 2021 event seeing 11 heroic entrants completing a 35-mile route across wild Dartmoor in 2021, the challenge is back by popular demand! This year our trekkers have the choice of walking 35 or 45 miles for an extra bit of challenge. The Ten Tors event has always been aimed at young people and is a life changing experience. South Dartmoor Community College's Outdoor Education team are offering spaces to adults to complete their challenge routes over two days including camping and navigating across 10 Dartmoor Tors to raise money to enable disadvantaged students to take part in expeditions run by the team in the coming years.

You will be supported by the Outdoor Education team and training will start months before the event. You will be guided through every aspect of navigation, kit advice, what to wear and carry on the event, fitness advice, support, fundraising tips and encouragement on the day. Current Ten Tor participants will be on hand to share what got them through the miles.

At the end of the weekend successful participants will get a completion certificate, a celebratory medal and enjoy a well-earned pasty – just like the real event!
