





A Level Results for South Dartmoor Community College and Atrium Sixth Form

South Dartmoor Community College and Atrium Sixth Form is celebrating another set of strong A Level results, maintaining its position as one of the highest performing sixth forms in the county. After a challenging 18 months, many students have still managed to attain top grades (A*) in one or more subject. More than 75% of students are on track to secure their first choice place at the top universities.

Almost three quarters of the grades students were awarded were A* - B and provisional projections suggest at least 50% of those applying to higher education will progress to a Russell Group university. There was also significant achievement in BTEC and CTEC studies, with 100% of students achieving distinction* or distinction.

Executive Head Teacher, Jen Veal, said: "I am so proud of all the students. They have worked hard under difficult circumstances to achieve the grades they needed to progress to their chosen higher education destinations. The students responded really well to the blended approach of remote teaching and face to face lessons, finding different ways to learn and succeed.
