Dear Parent / Carer

In the week beginning 13 June 2022, your child will be doing their end of year exam in Science. The purpose of this is to see how they have grasped the content in the GCSE foundation year and highlight any areas for us to focus on in Year 10. The assessment will be over two lessons and will be on the following topics;

- B2 Organisation (tissues, organs and organ systems)
- C2 Bonding and structure (chemical bonds and properties of ionic and covalent substances)
- P4 Electric circuits (current, voltage and resistance in series and parallel circuits)

These are topics that the Year 9 students have been studying over the past few months and form an important part of their Science understanding for the rest of their GCSE course.

To help with revision, the first port of call is Seneca. Teachers will set assignments that cover all of the content. This can be worked on over the next few weeks in preparation for the exam. BBC Bitesize and Youtube are also good resources and can be found by simply searching online for GCSE AQA Combined Science revision.
