INFORMATION REGARDING WEDNESDAY 1 FEBRUARY 2023 – NATIONAL STRIKE DAY

As you are aware, Wednesday 1 February is the first of a series of potential national strike days for teachers who are members of the National Education Union. We wrote to you last week to confirm that the college will only be open to students in Years 7, 11, 12 and 13. Sixth Form students will need to come into college ready to study independently, in case their teacher is absent on the day. Students who are in school will have their classes covered, where necessary, by Senior members of staff. Buses will run as normal on this day.

If your child is in Years 8, 9 or 10, they will have 3 hours of English, Maths and Science set on Classcharts in the usual way by the Curriculum Leaders. If students do not have their Classcharts code they can speak to their tutor who will be able to reissue it.

Finally, if your child is eligible for Free School Meals, we will be emailing out a further communication on voucher codes and how they can be redeemed.
