## **END OF TERM UPDATE**

As we near the end of term, I write to thank you all for your support. Once again, we have had an incredibly productive term and the students have continued to make me very proud to work here. Do look out for our termly Newsletter, which will be with you shortly, to get an idea of the successes, the opportunities and the events that have taken place this term.

What has become abundantly clear, following the tremendous success of last year's Year 11 cohort, is that community involvement is key to achieving the best for our young people. With that in mind, we surveyed parents / carers a couple of weeks ago regarding how you would prefer to meet staff to talk about your child's progress. In Years 11, 12 and 13 there was an overwhelmingly positive response to holding remote meetings over the Parents' Evening System, as we have been doing since Covid. In Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 there was still a preference for these to be remote, online meetings but the margin of preference was smaller. It is evident that you as parents would like more opportunity to meet staff face to face and to be able to come together as a community around our children.
