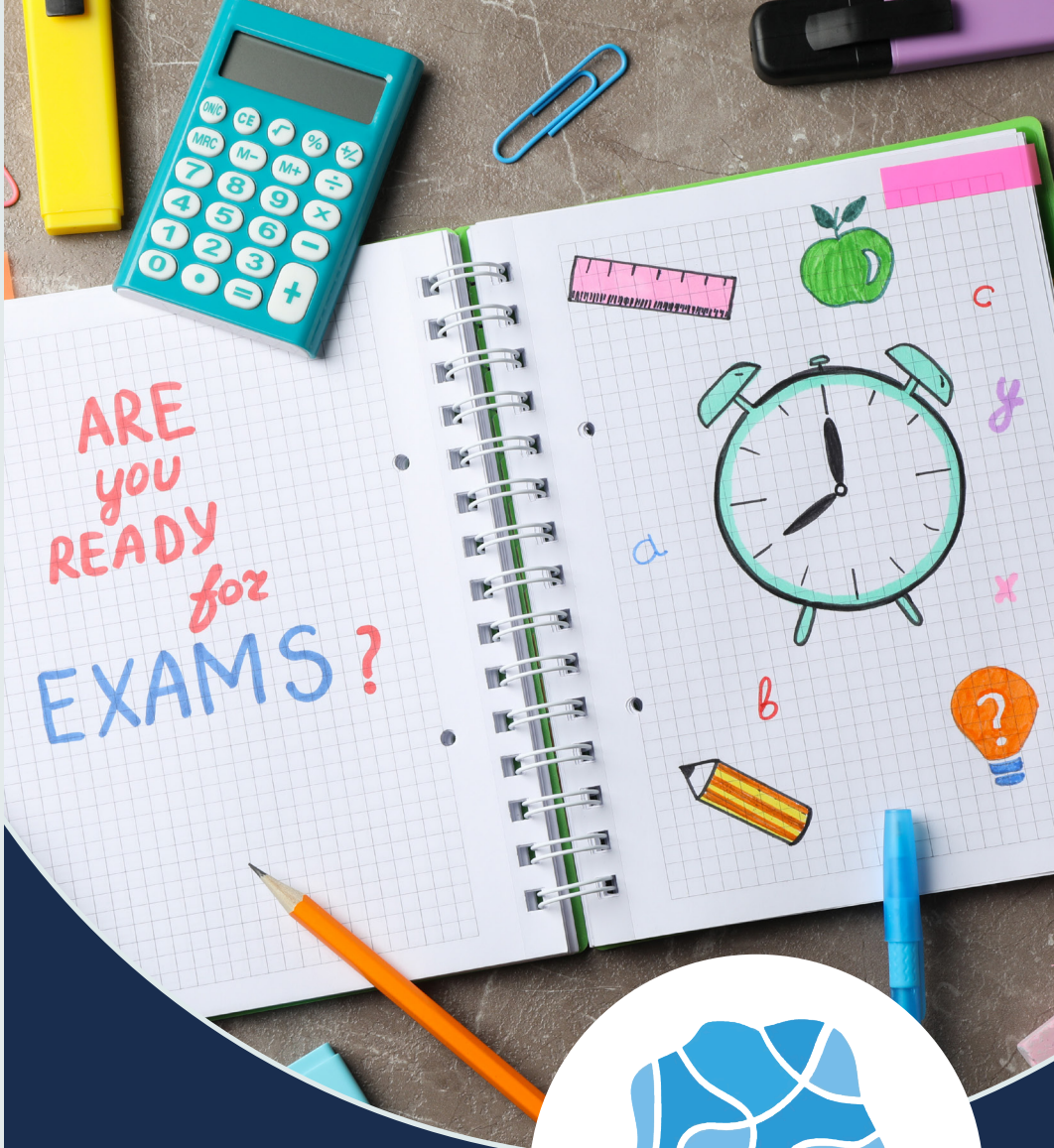
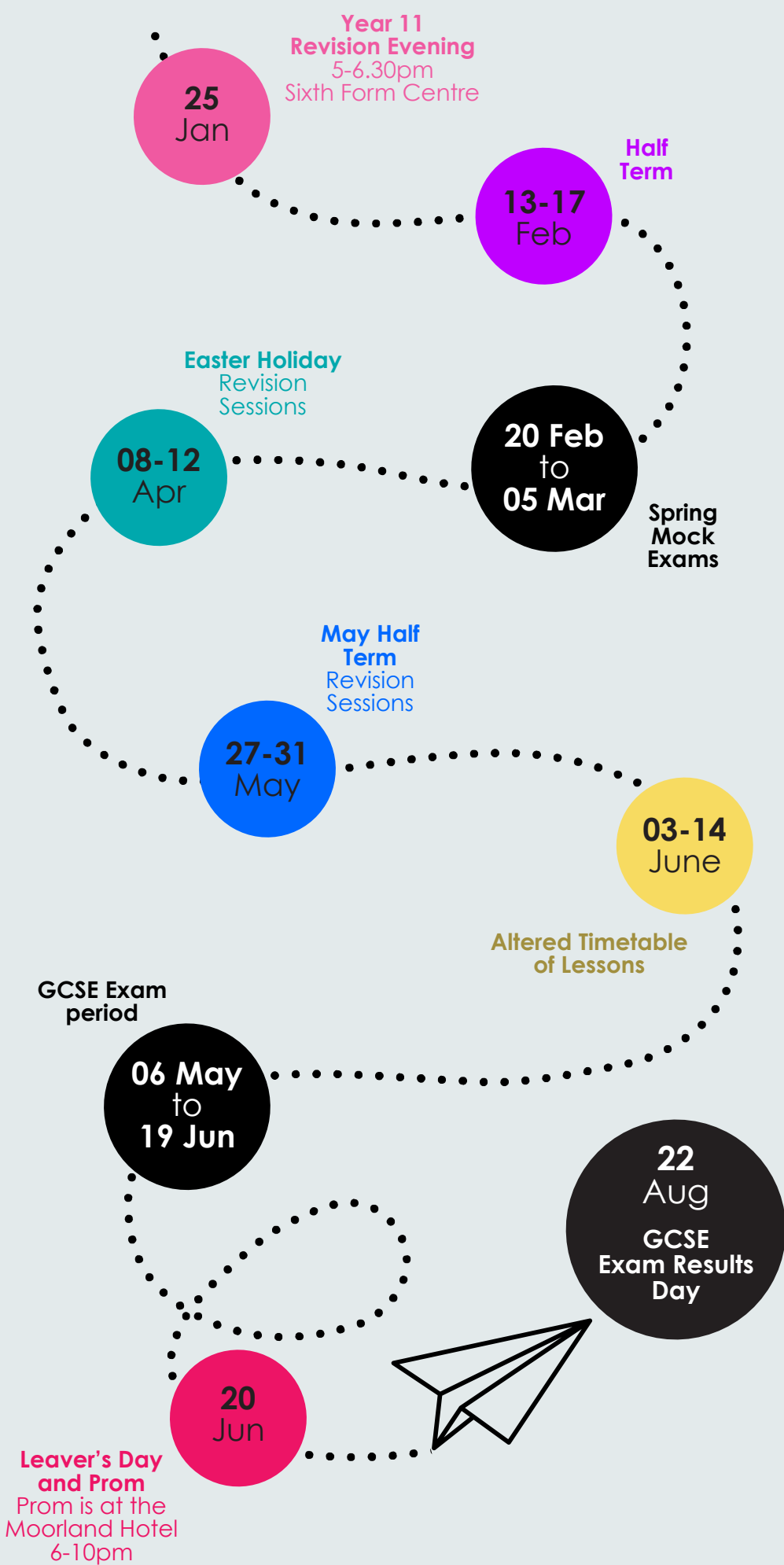

Top parent support tips:

Effective revision plays a crucial role in the run up to exams.

There are lots of ways you can help your child, from checking what they know and helping them remember things, to ensuring they are healthy and well rested.

1	Provide a calm and clear workspace with revision and exam timetables visible.
2	Do they have the right kit and equipment?
3	Reward and praise.
4	Boost their brain power by keeping them hydrated and eating the right foods.
5	Are they getting enough sleep (ideally 8-10 hours)?
6	Keep the wellbeing basics in place and plan in some time for fun.
7	Reassure, listen and support, and show them that you care.
8	Don't pretend it is not stressful. Don't make comparisons. Don't show your stress.
9	Attendance - every school day missed equates to 5 hours of learning/course content.

Attendance matters


Days off cost good grades.

Research suggests that for every 17 days missed from school, your GCSE results go down one grade!
