

RATIONALE

Every establishment should have a mission and vision statement, supported by explicit and shared values. Everyone within the organisation should understand and adhere to these, as they are the foundations of the institution and should underpin everything.

A **Vision Statement** articulates where we want to be. A **Mission Statement** sets out what we are going to do now to get there. The **Values** set out the manner in which (or how) we will achieve our aims. Rather like a recipe (for success), the vision determines what we are trying to make (the product), the mission is the recipe (method) and the values are like the ingredients.
