



GCSE PE Video Evidence Guidance

You are allowed to use sports you do outside of school as an activity assessment area for your GCSE PE Practical. You will need to provide video evidence of this, which your class teacher will mark and keep, before passing it on to the exam board. In order to stay within the AQA guidelines, please follow the points below:

- Collect the criteria for the sport from your class teacher. - **THIS WAS DONE LAST YEAR.**
- Ensure you read the criteria so you know EXACTLY what is required. **It must ALL be on the footage** (Part A and B).
- For Part B, the game/competitive situation MUST be continuous, and it must show the ENTIRE game.
- Read the assessment criteria for 'performer', which you can ask your teacher for.
- If you are filming an activity where there are others in the footage too, ensure you are wearing a distinctive colour, a different colour bib or a clear number on your back/hat etc.
- ***At the beginning of your footage, state clearly for the camera 'my name is Joe Bloggs, candidate number 1234, centre number 54301 (I am wearing number 12)'***.
- Make sure your footage is transferred to DVD, with your name, candidate number and centre number clearly written on the disc.

All of this should be completed by February of Year 11.
