Year 12 Multi-Agency Impact Day – Thursday 10 July 2025

I am excited to announce a hugely impactful experience day designed to equip our young people with the skills and knowledge to keep themselves and others safe in any scenario. This event, featuring multi-agency input, will take place on Thursday, 10 July 2025, throughout the college day, in the Sixth Form Centre. Attendance is compulsory for all Year 12 students as part of their Personal Development Programme.

The day will begin with a scenario delivered to all students to thread the workshops together. Students will then take part in a series of 4 bespoke workshops that have been designed collaboratively with; Devon and Somerset Fire and Rescue Service, Devon and Cornwall Police and Road Safety Operations team, Devon Air Ambulance and SPACE Youth Services. The event is completely free to students.

Workshops Overview:

First on Scene: Students will engage in activities that empower them to respond appropriately when first on the scene of an incident, including first aid. They will develop the confidence and practical understanding to assess situations, ensure safety, and contact emergency services effectively.

Speed and Intervention: Students will explore how driving behaviours like speeding, distractions and driving under the influence, affect stopping distances and reaction times. They will critically assess common justifications and misunderstandings, recognising the lingering effects of impairment and distraction.

Healthy Relationships: Interactive activities will help students recognise the hallmarks of healthy and unhealthy relationships, navigate consent, seek support, and respectfully exit unfulfilling connections while maintaining self-worth.

Water Safety: Students will learn about water safety, including the use of throw lines and key knowledge on staying safe around water. They will gain a clear understanding of identifying potential risks and responding effectively in emergencies.

This event promises to be an invaluable experience, providing our students with essential life skills and the confidence to handle various situations safely. We look forward to your support in ensuring full attendance and participation.
