Somerset Cricket Trip – Monday 30 June

We have been invited by the Somerset Cricket Foundation to watch Somerset versus Nottinghamshire on **Monday 30 June** at the County Ground, Taunton. We have a limited number of tickets available, which will be **allocated at random on Monday 16 June**. Students will then be notified if they have a space on the trip. Anyone allocated a space will be requested to read and complete the information specified below.

Details of the Trip

The total cost for this trip is £9.00 to cover the cost of minibus hire. **Parents/carers must consent on Parent Pay by Monday 23 June**. You will also need to specify any medical information.

The County Ground is a cashless venue. However, for 'Schools Days' some vendors will be able to take cash. This means that children will be able to buy sweets, drinks, ice creams and cricket 'stuff' with cash but may not be able to purchase a full meal with cash so I would recommend bringing a packed lunch.

There is no expectation for students to wear school uniform, but students must ensure that clothing and footwear is appropriate for the weather forecast.

Students should meet outside the PE Office at 8:40 am, where they will be registered by a member of staff.

At the end of the day, we expect to leave Taunton by 14:00 and aim to be back at school in time for the buses at 15:10. If we are delayed by traffic, it would mean that you will need to arrange your own transport home. We will ask students to notify their parents before we leave the cricket ground.
