Additional English and Maths Support for Year 11 Students

Following the recent mock examinations, your child has been identified as having the capability to achieve a Grade 5 in both English and Maths but requires some targeted support in Maths to be secure in realising this. Achieving a Grade 5 in these core subjects is essential as it opens up a wide range of options for college courses and future career pathways.

To help your child reach these grades, we have secured the opportunity for additional Maths teaching during their PE, RS and Future Horizons lesson time, starting from Monday 1 December.

Of the five lessons allocated:

- Three lessons will be taught lessons focused on gaps in knowledge identified from the mock exams, key skills and exam preparation.
- Two lessons will be private study periods to allow students to complete home learning and revise effectively in preparation for the next set of mocks.

We believe this bespoke, targeted approach will make a significant difference to your child's outcomes and future choices.
