Year 9 Progress Evening and Options Information Evenings

Year 9 Progress and Options Information Evening – Thursday 5 March

This evening will run from 16:00 – 19:00 by video call and will offer you an opportunity to book two types of appointments. You will be able to book appointments about your son / daughter's progress in the subjects which are listed in the table below (left hand column). You will also be able to book appointments with teachers of options subjects, to learn important information about the courses that they run. They are listed in the table below (right hand column).

The evening will be run remotely with meetings via video calls using the 'Parents Evening System'. Each appointment lasts up to 5 minutes with a 30 second gap; this means conversations need to be really focused in order to make the most of the time. As a result, you may wish to prepare questions in advance so you can maximise the time. If, following the evening, you still find yourselves with unanswered questions or that simply time had run out before you had finished, please contact the member of staff directly and a further conversation can be arranged. This allows you to choose your own appointment time with teachers and you will receive an email confirming your appointment. Ian Squires will be available for appointments with students on the SEND register.

Split classes: Some subjects may have more than one teacher. In these cases, we suggest that you only need to make an appointment with one of the subject teachers.

Appointments can be made from Monday 23 February and will close on Tuesday 3 March at midnight. Appointments are booked on a first come first serve basis, and if the appointments for a particular teacher or subject are full, we encourage you to join the reserve list. Staff will see this and recognise that you would like to be contacted to discuss that particular subject.
