Dear Parent / Carer

Year 8 Progress Evening by Video Call - Appointment Booking

I would like to warmly invite you to attend our **Year 8 Progress Evening on Thursday 21 May from 16:00 – 18.30 by video call**. The evening will be an opportunity for you to talk to your son / daughter's subject teachers about their progress. We have written some key points below, which we hope will support you to make the most of this evening.

Timings: The evening will be run remotely with meetings via video calls using the 'Parents Evening System'. It is worth noting that each appointment lasts exactly 5 minutes (there is a timer in the corner of the screen) with a 30 second break between appointments. This means conversations need to be really focused in order to make the most of the appointment. As a result, you may wish to prepare questions in advance so you can maximise the time.

Subjects to book: It is not necessary to book with all subject teachers. We recommend parents make appointments with the core subject teachers, Maths, English and Science, followed by Humanities (Geography and History) and Modern Foreign Languages. These subjects make up over 65% of your child's timetable and will give you a good idea of how your child is doing at school.

Split classes: Some subjects may have more than one teacher. In these cases, we suggest that you only need to make an appointment with one of the subject teachers.

Other subjects: Due to the way our curriculum is structured, other subject teachers (including Art, Drama, PE, Music and Technology) may have multiple classes. This means, for these subjects in particular, appointments are limited, and we kindly ask that you only make appointments with these teachers if you have particular concerns or questions.

Should you be unable to make an appointment: In this case, please feel free to email the subject teacher directly and a conversation can be arranged. Staff email addresses are formed as follows; staff initial staff surname (no gap)[@southdartmoor.devon.sch.uk](mailto:southdartmoor.devon.sch.uk).
